Write down as much as you can about Pnyx Hill in thirty seconds.

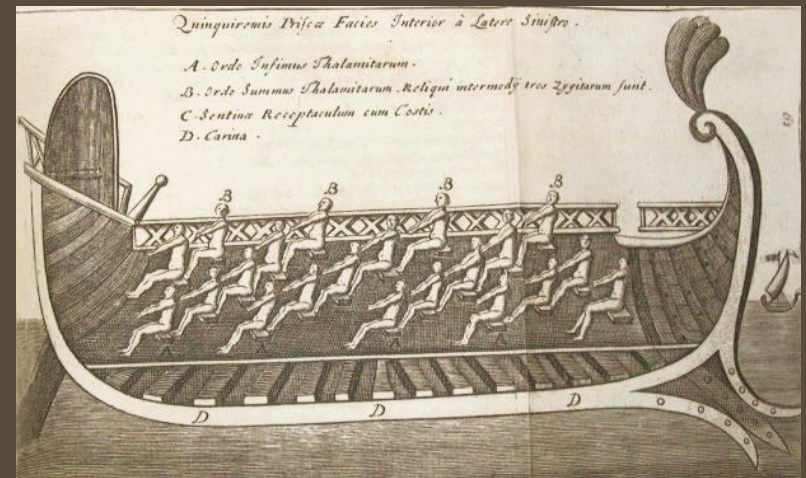
# QUINQUIREMES
